Dear Chairwomen Murray and DeLauro, and Ranking Members Blunt and Cole:

Thank you for your leadership on public health issues, particularly for establishing the new Chronic Disease Education and Awareness Program at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) through the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 appropriations process and funding the program with an initial investment of \$1.5 million. As you and your colleagues work develop the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Labor-HHS-Education Appropriations Bill, the undersigned organizations write to request a funding level of \$5 million for the CDC's Chronic Disease Education and Awareness Program to facilitate sustained growth and to initiate additional public health programs in key areas.

As demonstrated by the many organizations supporting this program and competitively seeking collaborative opportunities with CDC through the Chronic Disease Education and Awareness program, there is significant interest and will likely be a surplus of meritorious proposals. We understand from initial guidance that CDC intends to issue several multi-year cooperative agreements for FY 2021, which is a good use of resources when pursuing meaningful public awareness, professional education, and public health activities. It is our hope that additional funding will enable CDC to support more proposals in subsequent years. In the interest of growing the program, supporting timely public health efforts, and ensuring the viability and effectiveness of emerging opportunities, please provide this new program with \$5 million for FY 2022.
