Dear Chairmen Upton and Pitts and Ranking Members Pallone and Waxman:

We, the undersigned, write to express our support for retaining mandatory funding for school-based health centers (SBHCs) in section 4101(a) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Affordable Care Act).

Providing a one-time series of grants for construction, renovation, and equipment for school-based health centers was the right decision. More than 1,900 SBHCs across the country provide access for nearly two million students, and a range of primary, mental, and oral health care services. These services are provided regardless of students' ability to pay in a location that meets children and adolescents where they are: at school. SBHCs are often the only source of health care for many children and adolescents who would otherwise go without needed services.

No other source of federal funding uniquely supports SBHCs, even though government studies have demonstrated that the model is a critical and cost-effective part of our nation's health care safety net for children and adolescents.

More than 350 applicants from around the nation are seeking funding through the first round of competitive grants (HRSA-11-127) created under the law – demonstrating the high level of interest in and need for this funding. These applications came from all regions of the country, representing rural, urban, and suburban constituencies.

Support for SBHCs in the Affordable Care Act will fund construction, renovation, and equipment. More money will go to construction jobs, renovation supplies, and equipment such as exam tables and blood pressure monitors. In addition to the benefits for student health, these grants are good for local businesses.

Most importantly, school-based health centers keep students healthy, in school, and learning. Stronger school-based health centers will lead to stronger, more successful children and adolescents across the country.

We, the undersigned, respectfully call on Congress to protect needed access to health care for vulnerable children and adolescents by retaining funding for SBHCs in the Affordable Care Act.
